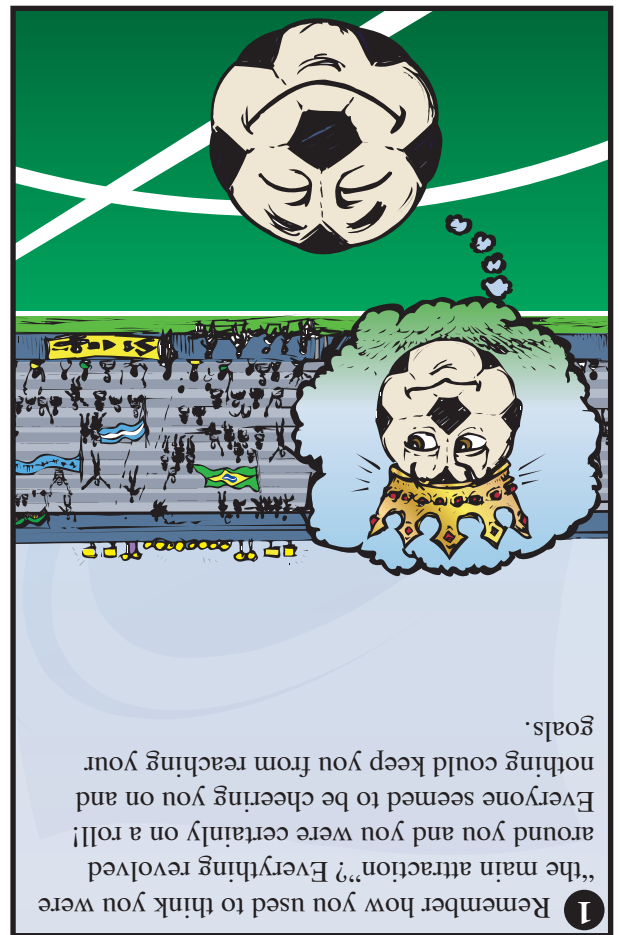

The Bible promises: "Yet to all who received [Jesus], to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:12).

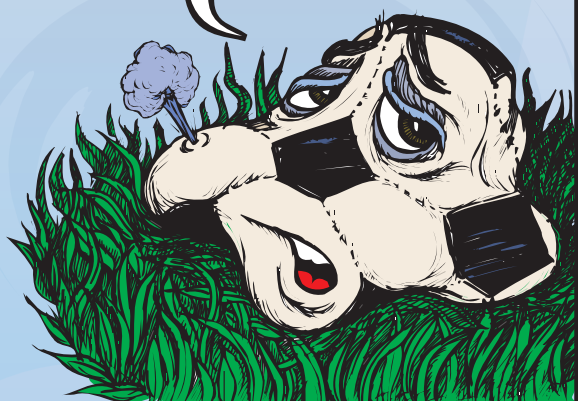

Come with me. My father made you and I came to take you back to him.

Wow! What could be better than this?



5 By now you've figured out that this isn't your average soccer story. It's a parable about how God, our very own Creator, sent his Son as living proof of his love for us. You see, every last one of us got on the wrong side and became enemies of God by the bad choices* we made in life: namely, to leave him out, to ignore his will and to outright disobey him. That's why he sent his Son Jesus: to die for our sins so we can get on God's winning team.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).



(*) Remember: what we choose determines what we become. That's why sin is so dangerous.

6 Yes, sin is like a big wall that separates us from God. And there is nothing we can do to deserve or buy our way through it. God, however, provided one way we can get through to him and He offers it to us free*: Jesus' death on the cross. Now it is up to you. Will you accept his offer? He gave you his life, will you give him yours?

(*) It wasn't free for God since it cost Him the life of His Son!

"Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me'" (John 14:6).
